

## LIONS CLUB OF GEORGETOWN LIFT DONATION, 16 JAN 2012

A PAST president of Lions Club of George Town wanted to do something special to mark his 50th wedding anniversary.

He donated RM45,000 towards the cost of the lift at the new premises of the Women's Centre for Change (WCC) on Jalan Burmah, Penang,

Tan Kheng Liat said he and his wife Khor Kah Hoon were grateful to God for 50 happy years of marriage.

"I'm also contributing to WCC as they are working for a good cause.

"They help by providing services for the less fortunate," said Tan at an the appreciation ceremony of the sponsorship of the new WCC premises on Saturday.

The couple celebrated their golden wedding anniversary on Dec 27 last year.

Lions Club of George Town president Andrew Choong and event organising chairman Peter Chung also donated RM45,000 for the cost of the lift to provide accessibility for the disabled and the elderly.

In her speech, WCC president Mariam Lim said that the organisation had moved a few days earlier to the new three-storey building worth RM2.5mil.

Previously, they operated in a cramped facility on Jalan Jones.

"To date, the WCC has raised RM1.25mil, which is 50% of our 'Give, Build, Change' building fund target," she said.

It was earlier reported that the total target of RM2.5mil was to cover the building cost of RM1.5mil and the renovation cost of up to RM1mil.

The WCC is a non-profit tax-exempt organisation helping abused women and children to end violence in their lives.
